

Chris Mitton – The Making of 'Fragile Peace'

Chris Mitton's latest sculpture, 'Fragile Peace' (2012) was hand carved from a block of Italian Carrara marble. The 3:1 scale sculpture of the Colt 45 revolver commonly known as the 'Peacemaker' took him six months to complete, working from a replica of the original gun. These images reveal something of his arduous process and give a wonderful insight into the artist's stone carving method, from unworked block to finished sculpture.





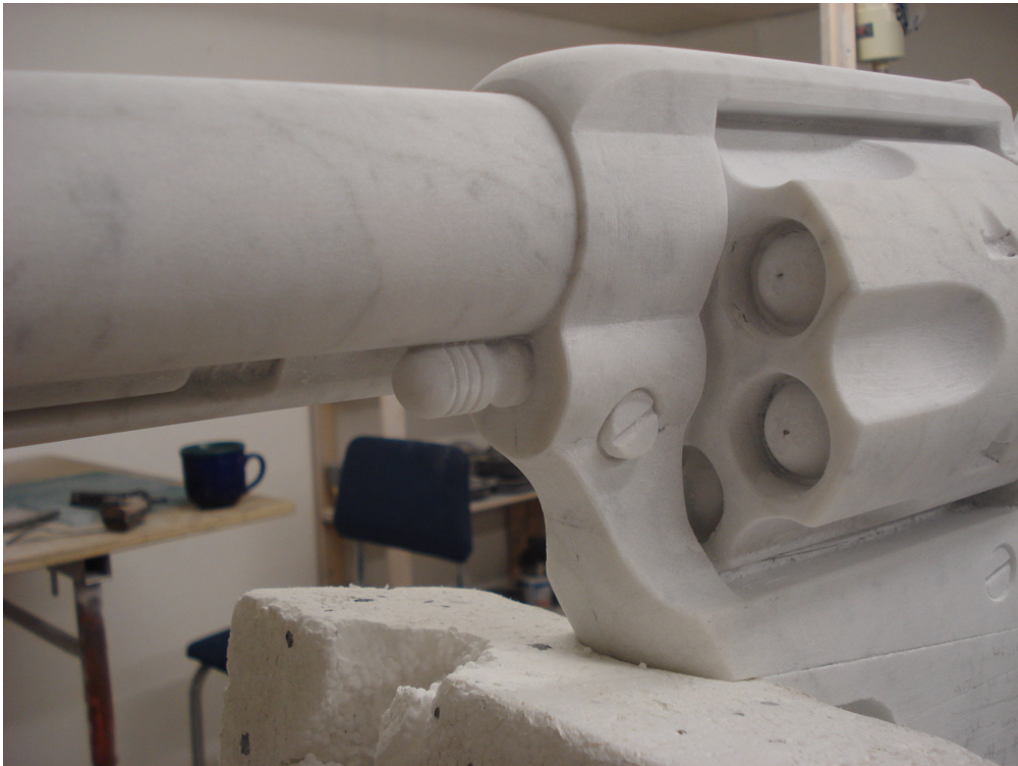


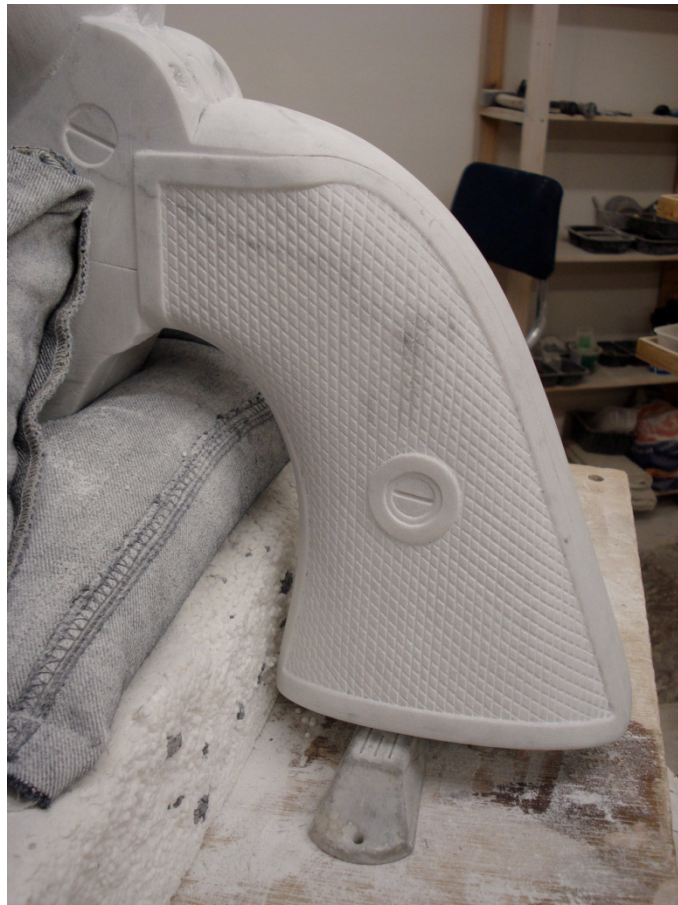

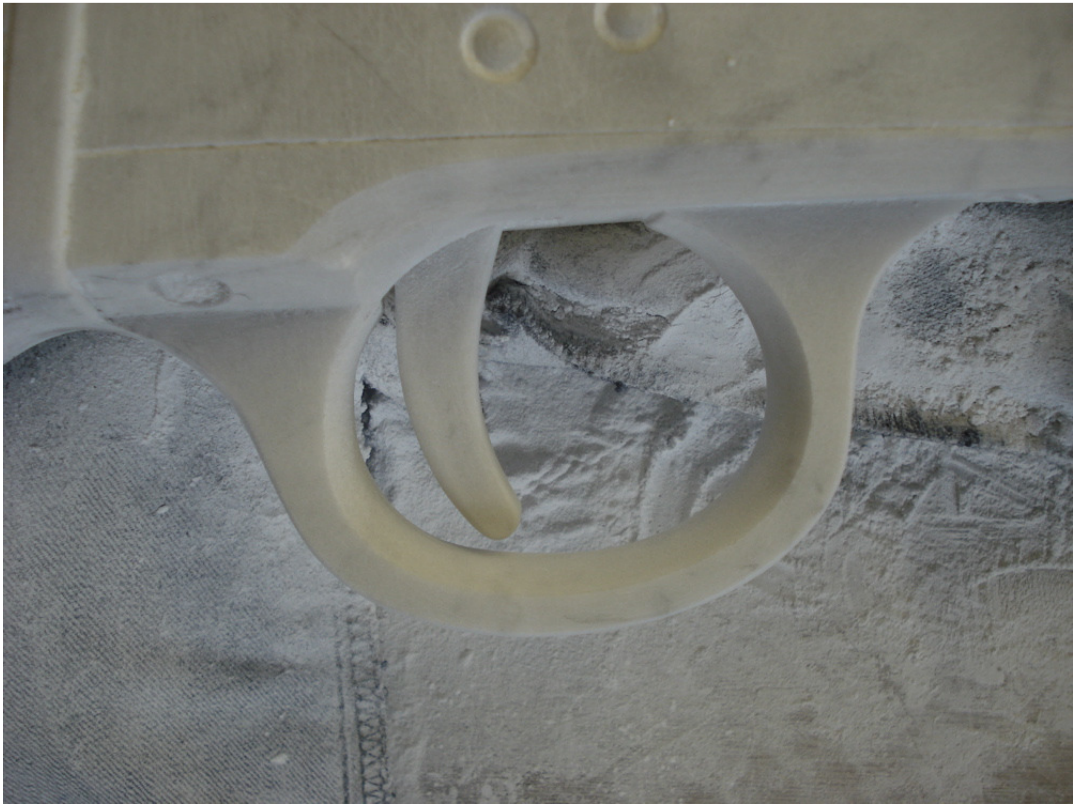
