Artist's Statement

'I created this artwork as part of the 'Revalue' series of sculptures, in which the cultural value of everyday, iconic objects is reflected through the time and skill invested in their re-interpretation in a classic sculptural medium.'

'After looking at hundreds of images of the Contour bottle and familiarising myself with all the detail and lettering changes, I decided to represent the ageless quality of the design by re-creating the original 1915 bottle.'
