Stephen Walter's drawings are a tangle of signs, words and images that draw the viewer into the artist's intricate worlds. Inspired by the continually unfolding drama of his home city, his iconic map of London and collection of meticulously detailed London Boroughs celebrate 'a city's ability to constantly reinvent itself, building on top of what was before, continually shifting its cultural identity.' In each print he combines history, trivia, personal experience, local knowledge and imaginative additions to creatively explore the area in all its contradictory complexity.

'The Island: London Series' was published by TAG in 2008 and has been the focus of sustained critical acclaim ever since. Stephen's work has been acquired for the Government Art Collection, V&A Museum, British Library and London Transport Museum among others.

TAG Fine Arts is a contemporary art dealer and publisher based in Islington and specialising particularly in limited editions.

Fenton House is a seventeenth-century merchant's house in Hampstead, North London, and a National Trust property.
