About the Artist

As an artist Stanley Donwood veers from propagandist graphics to introspective illustrations, but a consistent strength is his combination of deep personal and political emotions with modesty and humour; weighty subjects examined not entirely seriously but certainly respectfully. Since 1994 he has worked with Radiohead, his evocative and haunting imagery helping to create one of music's most distinctive brands.

Donwood developed his maps in response to a visit to Los Angeles. Not a driver himself and confronted with a vast city 'scaled for private motor vehicles,' he travelled in friend's vehicles, taxis and buses to explore the city's brash visual world. Back in the contrasting calm of Oxfordshire, Donwood painted his own artistic responses, using bold colours. mapping LA's districts in a vibrant but crowded visual plane.

Donwood's most recent series of prints developed out of two projects he undertook concurrently, creating the artwork for Radiohead's King of Limbs, and illustrating the Faber-published book 'Holloway.' Both projects were partly inspired by the wonders of the English countryside, and this theme is a continued presence in his limited edition prints, in which a range of arboreal scenes are depicted. Within the artworks forests, trees and hidden country paths are transformed by Donwood's imaginative vision into brightly coloured vistas, peopled by ethereal spectres.
