## **About the Artist**

Frank Fischer is a Jerwood Painting Prize winner makes abstract paintings by pouring household gloss paint onto steel stretchers. The technique relies on a combination of the ordered selection of colour and the workings of change to create a result which is unashamedly seductive. Frank's pieces produce a controlled aesthetic and contemplative environment to the viewer.

Recent works are derived from classical paintings by the masters such Bonnard and Turner. These compositions are achieved by extracting the colour through the horizontal which are then expressed in an abstract manner on to aluminium maintaining their original references.
