About the Artist

"I would like to grasp the light to plywood by a hand instead of exposing the film." Katsutoshi Yuasa makes woodcut prints from his own digital photographs. By combining two processes – the camera's 'snapshot' and the woodcut's lengthy reinterpretation of the same image – he hopes to crystallise the atmospheric and emotional character of his subjects. His pieces take weeks to complete, as he painstakingly translates details of light and shadow onto plywood ready for printing. The finished products exist as objects and images in their own right, removed from the original scenes that inspired them but still communicating their abstract appeal to the artist. The contrast between Yuasa's demanding and time-consuming traditional medium, and his choice of ephemeral subjects serves to transform his works into something beyond fleeting everyday experience.

Since graduating from RCA in 2006, Yuasa has undertaken multiple international residencies. His first London solo exhibition was held in 2009 at The Daiwa Foundation, Japan House in collaboration with TAG Fine Arts. In 2010, his work was selected for inclusion in Paul Coldwell's book, 'Printmaking: A Contemporary Perspective,' published by Black Dog Books and in 2011 he won the RA Summer Exhibition Towry Print Prize and the Northern Print Prize.
